





Unpack & Set Up

The UP2000 Kit from Alpha Processor, Inc. is configured as a single or dual processor system. A single motherboard supports one or two Alpha Slot B Processor Cartridges.



Remove the components carefully from their cartons and anti-static packaging bags.

Always take appropriate electrostatic discharge safety measures when handling boards or cartridges.

Mounting Requirements

Chassis Mounting Holes

Identify the **ten** standard Extended ATX mounting holes.

Check for the **eight** Slot B goalpost mounting holes.


For chassis or enclosures without this mounting hole pattern, obtain a drill template or chassis mounting tips from our website.

Slot B goalposts must be securely fastened to chassis backplate.

Attach to Chassis

Motherboard & Goalposts to Chassis Assembly


The goalposts hold Alpha Slot B cartridges securely in place on the UP2000 motherboard.

Requirements for attaching motherboard and goalposts fixture to the chassis are:

- Fastening Hardware Eight Slot B captive nut shoulder screw and washers.
 - Eight M4x6mm long Phillips pan head screws.
 - Assorted standoffs, screws, and miscellaneous hardware supplied by chassis vendor.
- Tools Phillips head screwdriver, Flat head screwdriver, torque wrench, nut driver (1/4").
- Proper chassis mounting holes drilled for goalpost captive nuts.

Use this mounting technique:

- 1. Align the goalposts fixture holes with the corresponding motherboard clearance holes.
- 2. Affix goalposts to motherboard from the backside using captive nuts and torque to 8 inch/lbs.
- 3. Affix goalpost brace to goalpost assembly. Torque to 4 inch/lbs. (As shown in Section C Mounting Requirements.)
- 4. Secure this assembly to the chassis with the standoffs and screws supplied by the chassis vendor.
- 5. Secure M4x6mm screws through chassis to goalpost captive nuts.






Install Memory DIMMs

Memory Configuration

The memory subsystem is comprised of:

- Two DIMM banks, designated Bank 0 and Bank 1.
- Each bank has four slots (sockets) that accept 168 pin PC100 SDRAM PLL Register based SPD DIMMs.
- Slots are configured in an alternating pattern.

Before installing DIMMs, carefully review the picture and guidelines shown below.



Memory Guidelines


- A bank **must** be fully populated (all four assigned slots must be utilized).
- Bank 0 must be populated first.
- A bank must utilize the same type, size, and speed DIMMs.
- Bank 0 and Bank 1 do **not** have to have same type, size, and speed DIMMs.
- Memory is supported in a size range between 256 MB (min) to 2 GB (max).







Use slots J6 through J12 for access to ISA and PCI bus support.




VIDEO OPTION MUST BE INSTALLED ON PCI BUS 0

Use sockets J24, J30, J31, J32, J33 to connect various disk peripheral devices.





Install Cartridges



Alpha Slot B Processor Cartridges


Use these components with special care. They weigh approximately three pounds each. A wire handle provides a convenient mechanism for safely inserting them.


Use this procedure to install Alpha Slot B cartridges:

- Remove the Primary goalpost cover.
- Insert a Cartridge in Primary Slot (J23) for a single processor system.
- Use an insertion force of 35 pounds to seat the cartridge just below the goalpost.

Note: A single processor system must use the Primary Slot.

- Remove the Secondary goalpost cover.
- Insert a second Cartridge in Secondary Slot (J22) for a dual processor configuration.
- Place a processor cover over each Cartridge installed.
- Fasten each processor cover using its captive screw.


System Support



Jumper Configuration

Four jumper blocks must be configured. Use the following diagrams to set up the UP2000 System.

Note the pin numbering orientation of each jumper block.




Initial System Test

Follow this procedure to confirm the proper installation of the UP2000 system:

- Ensure that all cables and modules are seated properly.
- Insert setup diskette in floppy drive.
- Turn on power.
- During the AlphaBIOS system initialization process, press F2 to enter Setup.

AlphaBIOS Setup Screen

The AlphaBIOS Setup screen appears. User is ready to load the operating system.
